Free Park & Ride Service

Park & Walk

Bypass event traffic and head to Tingley Beach to park and walk to the garden gates on select nights. River of Lights is a walk-through event...what a great way to get some more steps in!

- Carpool and ride share: Eliminate parking hassles by carpooling with friends and family or catching a ride together
- Plan your visit weekdays during the first part of the event: Mondays through Thursdays are typically less crowded, especially the first two weeks of River of Lights
